**UNITED LABOR CREDIT UNION PRESIDENT VOGLER FEATURED GUEST ON KKFI,**

**HEARTLAND LABOR FORUM RADIO PROGRAM JANUARY 28**

(KANSAS CITY, MO) – Tune in to KKFI 90.1 FM Thursday, January 28, 2010, at 6 p.m., for The Heartland Labor Forum radio program “Financial Re-regulation: Is the Fix In? And, Credit Unions: Are they Better?” with featured guest, United Labor Credit Union (ULCU) President, Tim Vogler. The hour-long show’s main focus will be on how financial deregulation contributed to the current economic crisis, what kind of re-regulation is needed and who is designing it. Some time will be spent learning about credit unions where Vogler will cover governmental oversight, insurance and generally how credit unions differ from banks. Vogler will contrast the credit union-bank philosophy and share the positive influence a financial cooperative provides to consumers, especially to the Labor community. He’ll also discuss why credit unions are a more-than-viable financial alternative to banks.

Vogler is a finance-degreed 25-year veteran of the credit union movement, and is serving in his seventh year as President of ULCU. The hosts of the show will be Shawn Saving and Carolyn Szczepanski.
